

BOSTON MUTUAL'S ACCIDENT POLICY PROVIDES THE FOLLOWING BENEFITS:

<u>Air Ambulance</u>	\$500	→	Within 48 hours after the covered accident.
<u>Ambulance</u>	\$100	→	Within 90 days of the covered accident.
<u>Appliance</u>	\$100	→	Within 90 days after the covered accident. For mobility and personal locomotion.
<u>Blood/Plasma/Platelets</u>	\$300	→	Within 90 days of the covered accident.
<u>Burns</u>	\$750 to \$10,000	→	Treated by a physician within 72 hours after the covered accident. Scheduled amount based on degree of burn. Skin grafts are 25% of the burn benefit.
<u>Concussion</u>	\$100	→	Diagnosed by a physician within 72 hours after the covered accident.
<u>Dislocations (Separated Joint)</u>	\$50 to \$8,000	→	Based on the type of surgery and joint involved.
<u>Emergency Dental Work</u>	\$50 to \$150	→	Based on whether tooth is extracted or crowned.
<u>Emergency Room Treatment</u>	\$50	→	Examination and treatment within 72 hours after the covered accident. Can be increased by \$100, \$200 or \$300 with the Enhanced Emergency Room Benefit Rider.
<u>Eye Injury</u>	\$200	→	Within 90 days of the covered accident.
<u>Follow-Up Physician Treatment</u>	\$50	→	Within 90 days of the covered accident.
<u>Fractures</u>	\$25 to \$10,000	→	Based on the type of surgery and bone involved.
<u>Hospital Admission</u>	\$1,000	→	(\$2,000 if immediately admitted into Intensive Care Unit) Within 6 months after the covered accident.
<u>Hospital Confinement</u>	\$250 per day up to 365 days	→	Within 6 months after the covered accident.
<u>Hospital Intensive Care</u>	\$500 per day up to 30 days	→	The confinement must begin within 30 days after the covered accident.
<u>Initial Physician's Office/Urgent Care Visit</u>	\$50	→	Within 60 days after the covered accident. Can be increased by \$25 or \$50 with the Enhanced Physician Office/Urgent Care Treatment Benefit Rider.
<u>Lacerations</u>	\$25 to \$400	→	Repaired by a physician within 72 hours after the covered accident. Paid based on the total length of all lacerations received in any one covered accident.
<u>Lodging</u>	\$100 per night	→	Up to 30 days per covered accident. Hospital must be more than 100 miles from the insured person's residence.
<u>Major Diagnostic Exams</u>	\$150	→	Per calendar year for CT scan, MRI or EEG as the result of a covered accident.
<u>Physical Therapy</u>	\$25 per day	→	Maximum of 6 days. Within 6 months of covered accident.
<u>Prosthetic Device/Artificial Limb</u>	\$500 to \$1,000	→	Within 1 year of the covered accident.
<u>Rehabilitation Unit</u>	\$150 per day	→	When confined in a rehab unit following hospitalization. Up to 30 days.
<u>Ruptured Disc</u>	\$400	→	Treated by a physician within 60 days after the covered accident and repaired through surgery within 1 year after the covered accident.
<u>Surgery (Abdominal or thoracic)</u>	\$1,000	→	Within 72 hours after the covered accident. Benefit is \$100 if exploratory surgery with no repair. Hernia repair will not be covered.
<u>Tendon/Ligament/Rotator Cuff</u>	\$150, \$600 or \$900	→	Must be repaired within 90 days after the covered accident. The benefit is based on the number of repairs needed and repaired through surgery.
<u>Torn Knee Cartilage</u>	\$750	→	Treated by a physician within 60 days and repaired through surgery within 6 months after the covered accident. Benefit is \$150 if exploratory arthroscopic surgery with no repair.
<u>Transportation</u>	\$300 per round trip	→	Up to 3 round trips per covered accident. For treatment more than 100 miles roundtrip from your home.
