As we begin our fall term, we want to share some changes to our COVID-19 protocol. Please be assured that we continue to be committed to the well-being of our community.

What WE are doing

- The Institute requires new hires and incoming members to provide proof of having completed a COVID-19 vaccination and one booster obtained in 2022 before gaining oncampus access to offices, libraries, seminars, meetings, and other resources.
- All visitors are expected to be vaccinated and have one booster but will not be required to submit proof.
- Any visitor who is not vaccinated due to an accommodation is required to wear a face covering at all times, unless eating or drinking.
- There will be three booster shot clinics throughout the academic year with one in October, one in January, and one in March.



What You are being asked to do:

- Be courteous of others. Individual are eligible to develop their own mask policy for people entering their work space.
- Do not use phones, desks, offices or work tools and equipment belonging to others.
- Adhere to all IAS policies and practices, both general and Covid-19 related.
- Talk to HR if you have concerns specific to your circumstances, such as a health condition that places you or someone in your household at high risk.
