Intisar A. Rabb is a Professor of Law at Harvard Law School and a director of its Islamic Legal Studies Program. She also holds an appointment as a Professor of History at Harvard University and as a Susan S. and Kenneth L. Wallach Professor at the Radcliffe Institute for Advanced Study. In 2015, she received awards from the Luce Foundation and the MacArthur Foundation for SHARIAsource — an online portal for content and context on Islamic law, designed to make available primary sources as well as informed scholarly commentary about them more accessible and useful. She has published on Islamic law in historical and modern contexts, including the monograph, *Doubt in Islamic Law* (Cambridge University Press 2015), an edited volume, *Law and Tradition in Classical Islamic Thought* (with Michael Cook et al., Palgrave 2013), and numerous articles.

Sharon Tai is the Deputy Editor at SHARIAsource, where she manages technical development and content production. Prior to SHARIAsource, Tai worked at the American Chamber of Commerce in Amman, Jordan. Tai's research interests are in constitutional law, Islamic law, and the possibilities of applying big data as a research method in these areas.
